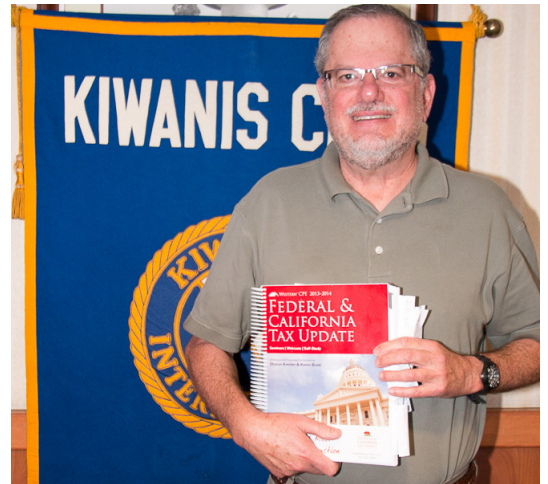
LAST TUESDAY

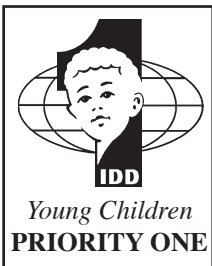
