Senior Planner for Temple City Joe Lambert made another visit to give yet another update on projects and plans. Joe did a great job fielding our questions, most of them regarding the on and off again Piazza Project.

Joe also handed out pamphlets of programs that the City provides to its residents and businesses including the "Handyworker Assistance Program" which provides a grant of \$10,000 that does not need to be paid back. If your household income for 2 persons is \$47,350 or less a year, you qualify.

The "Facade Improvement Program" allows a cash rebate of up to \$25,000 for business owners who remodel their storefronts, paint, landscape, awnings and canopies, signs and lighting. This is a great gift of the City to help some businesses with a "face lift". About \$250,000 is budgeted for this program each year. Many businesses have already taken advantage of this program. The city also has an excellent staff member who will help you with design at no charge.

Editor's Note: When we did some improvements 2 years ago I wanted to participate in this program, but I had a legal non-conforming sign (that can be seen from Rosemead Blvd.) that would have to be removed to participate. My sign and building are the antithesis of art deco and I did not want to remove a 2-story high sign with cheesy neon or plastic. Also it is my understanding that you can apply for this program every year.
