Joe Austin and Al Hardecky from Interquest Detection Canines brought their prize interdiction dog Rebel.

Interquest was hired by the district in 1996. They come to Temple City High School, Oak Avenue, and The Learning Center unannounced as they check for drugs, alcohol, gun based powder, and abused medications.

They enter a classroom unannounced and move all the students along a wall as the dog goes up and down each aisle and walks past the students. If the dog finds something of suspicious nature it will sit and wait for instructions. Their sense of smell is 4,000 times better than humans. They also check common areas, bathrooms, lockers, and parking lots.

The dogs are usually non-aggressive breeds such as Labradors. Their dogs come from shelters or are rescue dogs. They look for that certain personality that would fit their need. Both Al and Joe said that of all the districts they serve Temple City is one of the cleanest.

I spoke with John Chandler Wednesday and he is recovering just fine and doing well. He has limited use right now on his left side and is walking with the aid of a three-prong walker. John would like to convey his thanks to all the members who have sent cards and called. He said he hopes to be back a club meeting in about 2 weeks.
