Her dedication to the industry has led becoming farrier liaison for the 1984 Olympic Games, official horseshoe inspector for the Tournament of Roses. She is also a member of the California Thoroughbred Foundation Board of Directors. Ada was inducted into the American Farriers Hall of Fame.

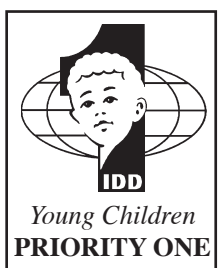
