Nick Gladis from the Temple City Historical Society will go down memory lane with Temple City history. Our own Dan Snell is President of this lively group.

LAST TUESDAY

Dr. Chris Carlos is Chief Deputy Assessor for Los Angeles County. The Assessor's office is responsible to more than 10 million people in 88 cities plus unincorporated areas. Their job is to place fair value on the county's 2.6 million residential, commercial, and utilities properties.

Chris reports that in 2011 property values increased by 1.49%, this year the projected increase is expected to be 1.7%. I think we can all agree that we are in a down economy right now. The bright spot is that our city will recover faster. Of the 88 cities in LA County we rank #3 in property values with San Marino and Walnut in the top spots. There is a reason we have not declined. My feeling is that Temple City is a great city to raise a family, an excellent form of city government, and our schools rank at the top in every category.

Chris is big on servant leadership and remembers who he works for. Constituents have a hard time with the difference between the Assessor and the Tax Collector. When a resident calls with a question Chris feels it is not good enough to say "that is not our department". Chris takes it to another level by giving out his cell phone number which is 213 369-1559. If you ever have a problem take him up on it.

Steve Tyre spoke of County Assessor John R Noguez as being very fair. Steve's family has many parcels of commercial property that needed the help of the Assessor's office. FYI: Southern California Edison is the highest payer of property taxes.

Guests of the Club in attendance were newly elected School Board Member Kien Tiet. Kien is a attorney in Temple City specializing in tax law. It was especially nice to have two School Board members in attendance in Matt and Kien as we conducted the Students of the Month.

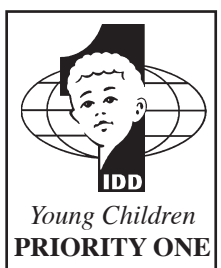
