LAST TUESDAY

Nick Gladis is a retired teacher and printer who happens to be the Historian and Curator of the Temple City Historical Society since 1998. The Society will be celebrating their 25th anniversary in June of this year.

They began with a city provided building at Live Oak Park and moved to the Women's Club about 5 years ago after they deeded it to the Society.

Kiwanis member, businessman, and Temple City Mayor Lou Merritt was the first president of the society in 1987.

Some things I learned was: Jonathan Temple started the first grocery store in Los Angeles which was on Temple Street of course. We had a recording company in Temple City called Winsor Recording that produced the old 45 RPM records. Temple City was home to the Kazoo Orchestra. TC was also the birthplace of the Winchell Donut chain (I went there to buy cigarettes in the vending machine because I was too young to buy them the regular way. 25 cents a pack). Temple City was previously Main Street, Cloverly was previously Ramona, Primrose was Dupree, and Live Oak Avenue was Azusa Avenue, now you know why Lower Azusa is called Lower Azusa.

In 1925 Temple City began 7 years of entering a float in the Tournament of Roses Parade.

Long time icon in Temple City, Al Lehine passed away at the age of 79. Al was born in Cairo, Egypt and came to the United States in 1954. He became a citizen in the country he loved deeply in 1961. He served in the United States Army for 2 years in the medical core. He attended Pharmacy School at Columbia University. He opened Brother's Pharmacy in 1969 on the South West corner of Las Tunas and Temple City Blvd. Where the Tea Station is now. In 1989 he moved to Vernon's Rexall Pharmacy on the same North West corner.

One thing I remember about Al is that he had a separate phone number at his home for customer emergencies. He would actually go to his store in off hours to dispense medicine. Try getting that at your local CVS. Al was a past president of Temple City Lions Club. He was also a founding member of the Temple City Tennis Club. Al was also General Chairman of the 50th Camellia Festival in 1994. There will be a celebration of his life at The Green Hotel in Pasadena on Sunday at 11:00 a.m.

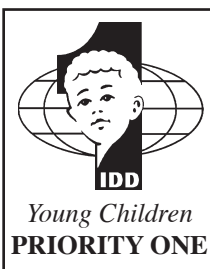
