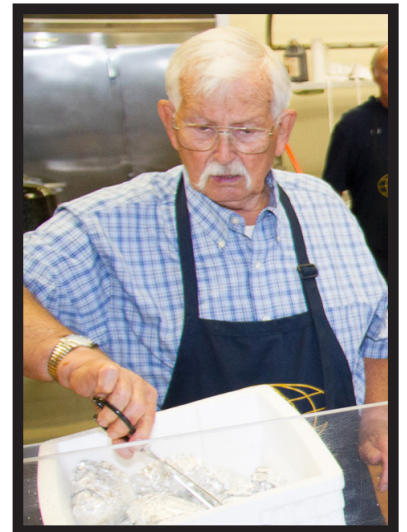
It was good to have Mike Miller back with us. He was sporting a black eye most likely given to him by Sue Matchett. Good to hear that John Chandler is back home now.
