Our own Dan Snell told "his story" of his 3 1/2 years serving in World War II. His travels took him all over the world serving in the Chemical Warfare Service. His happiest moment came when he received leave to marry his young bride June some 68 years ago.

This is truly the Greatest Generation. The war lasted from 1939 to 1945. The war directly involved more than 100 million people from 30 different countries. No one is sure just how many died in the conflict, but there are estimates of between 50 and 70 million casualties.

Approximately every two minutes a memory of World War II, its sights and sounds, its terrors and triumphs disappears. Yielding to the inalterable process of aging, the men a women who fought and won the great conflict are now in their 80s and 90s. They are dying quickly at the rate of 550 a day according to Veterans Administration figures. Thank you Dan for your service to our country!!
