Jane Chavez was selected as the Executive Director of the Pregnancy Help Center of San Gabriel Valley. The PHC affirms the dignity of life by providing sound alternatives to abortion and support for women experiencing crisis pregnancies. Parenting classes are held twice a month for free.

The Pregnancy Help Center has helped young women and their families for more than 20 years. They are the oldest operating center of its kind in Southern California, growing out of the original volunteers who founded the first 24-hour Pregnancy Help Line in 1970.

In 2008 Denise Aldahl, M.D. joined the Board. I am proud to say that Dr. Aldahl delivered two of our grandchildren. The use of the ultrasound machine is the most important tool. They are in need of a new unit with \$16,000 of the \$23,000 raised already. They have served 1,587 clients in 2012. After counseling and receiving an ultrasound, 75% of abortion minded clients have changed their minds and decided to carry their babies to full term! Temple City Kiwanis is proud to financially support the PHC-SGV monthly.
