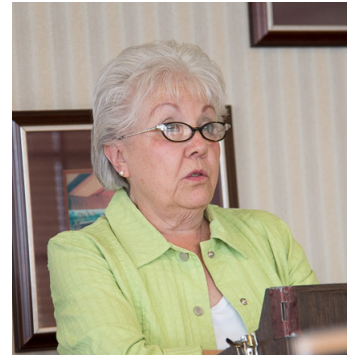
THIS TUESDAY

Originally limited to fighting in those colonies, after 1778 it also became a world war between Britain and France, Netherlands, Spain, and Mysore. American independence was achieved and European powers recognized the independence of the new United States, with mixed results for the other nations involved. It was interesting how many of our members knew so much about the Revolutionary War.
