He served in the Korean War in the Air Force as a photographer. He met Donna Green and they were wed in 1956. Elmer and Donna opened their own grocery store in San Gabriel called the "Grab 'N Run". Elmer was always interested in real estate and received his RE license in 1964 and began "flipping houses". He began his career with Herbert Hawkins on Rosemead Blvd and set out on his own in 1971 on Las Tunas Dr.

Elmer served two terms as Kiwanis President in 1986 and 2007. He will always be known to us as the "Corn Guy" and our Annual Barbecue. On July 18 I invite you to have an extra ear of corn to honor Elmer's life and legacy.
