Captain Tony Duran is a Safety Officer with the Los Angeles County Fire Department. Tony is married with 3 children and lives in Temple City. He was born in Guayaquil, Ecuador, South America and enjoys Martial Arts, reading, and SCUBA.

Tony told of the stress on running into burning structures when everyone else seems to be running out. Tony's job is to insure that all the safety procedures are in place when their is a major incident.

Undoubtably, Tony has seen things during his time in the military and now with the fire department that we will never see. With that comes stress. Whenever there is a major incident there is a "Critical Incident Stress Debriefing" the next day. If you were directly involved are invited to attend. No one else.

Just some of the things you might experience as a fireman are higher cancer risk, stress related problems, broken sleep patterns, and heart disease.

I have personally known Tony for 20 years and find him to be a wonderful public servant and family man.

A Personal Note: I would highly recommend the movie "Fireproof" to you. It stars Kirk Cameron formerly from the Growing Pains series. It is a low budget faith based movie about a fireman whose marriage is in trouble. In the movie the word fireproof is used a couple of times from one firefighter to another, specifically talking about marriage. What he says is, 'Look when something is fireproof, it doesn't mean that fire is never going to come to it.

When fire comes you are going to be able to withstand the heat,' and that is the idea behind fireproof and the marriage analogy. It is not about whether or not flames are going to come to your marriage, it is about when they come can you stand the heat are you going to be able to with stand it and out last it. Unfortunately many people today, most people today don't, and firefighters actually have a divorce rate of around 75% so it is really high but relevant for everybody."

The movie came out in September 2008 and can be rented at Blockbuster.
