El Monte icon Donna Crippen will give the early history of El Monte. I have heard her speak at the Historical Society and it is very interesting.

LAST TUESDAY

Mayor Pro Tem Carl Blum spoke of his 3 year odyssey with the Rosemead Improvement Project.

This is a major project for our city that covers 2 miles from the railroad tracks to Callita. This is a 20 million dollar project with one million by the city and 19 million funded through 14 different Federal, State, and County agencies. The actual construction cost are about 13 million with the balance going to engineering and design.

This project will provide many improvements including distinctive design, safety, better traffic control, plants and trees, art objects, and a dedicated bike lane that will be the envy of the nation.

The city is providing weekly construction updates with continuing progress, closures, and areas to avoid. The City has met with South Pasadena as they are going through their project on Fair Oaks. The secret is to hold the contractor to a tight work schedule. If you give them 2 years to finish a 18 month project they will take the 2 years and work on other projects.

Our city is fortunate to have Carl Blum and Vince Yu ramrodding this project. Carl in his position with the County did this for a living, and Vince brings his architect skills. Collectively, they have had over 80 meetings bringing this project to fruition. Also, City Manager Jose Pulido brings his skills after going through the same thing in San Fernando.

At the April 2 City Council meeting our club was recognized for donating \$400 supplying carts for seniors riding Dial-A-Ride.
