Teresa and Jim Diaz are Directors at the Ramona Museum of California History. It is located across from the Mission Playhouse in San Gabriel. They retired from teaching three years ago in Alhambra and then they joined the Native Sons of the Golden West. It is a fraternal order that works to preserve California History.

Teresa gave a slide show presentation of the life and times of Temple City founder Water Temple. It was interesting to hear how Walter Temple's influence was not only in Temple City but many surrounding cities.

The Native Sons of the Golden West was founded July 11, 1875 by General A. M. Winn, a Virginian, as a lasting monument to the men and women of the Gold Rush Days. General Winn lived in California during the Gold Rush and was impressed with the spirit and perseverance of the "Forty-Niners."

The chief objects of the Order as set forth in its constitution were, "To perpetuate in the minds of all native Californians the memories of the days of '49 to encourage a lively interest in all matters and measures relating to the promotion of the national interests and to the building of the State of California." Today, the Native Sons of the Golden West is open to membership from any native-born, current or former resident of California origin. The Native Sons of the Golden West is a charitable and fraternal organization. Organized locally into "Parlors," the group is perhaps best known for the large number of commemorative markers it has placed throughout the state.

Guests for the day included Marie Leonard and San Gabriel member Dr. Royce Foster who will be a program speaker in May. Our Club was one of the honorees at the City sponsored Volunteer Appreciation Luncheon on Saturday, April 11.
