Our program for the day was from Honor Flight. Marva X was our speaker. The mystery was solved when she told us of a bad marriage and now is using the last name of "X" to refer to her ex husband.

Marva is a Navy Brat of a World War II Veteran that joined in 1936 after running away from his grandfather's farm. In 2010 she joined the newly formed Honor Flight. They have assisted in sending for free 144 Veterans on 9 flights to Washington, DC through donations. No federal money!

Currently Honor Flight is focused on bringing veterans of World War II to the National World War II Memorial, and any veteran with a terminal illness to see the memorial of the war they fought in. Organizers plan to "naturally transition" their programs to focus on veterans of the Korean War, the Vietnam War, and subsequent wars as the veterans of those wars get older.

The veterans are generally escorted by volunteer guardians, who help them on the flight and around D.C. After landing, the taxiing airplane may be saluted by fire trucks, and passengers are often met by cheering crowds in D.C. or upon their return flight home.

Our own Dan Snell will board his Honor Flight with his son on May 8. Congratulations Dan...You Deserve It for your service to this wonderful country protecting our freedom.
