In 1984 under the direction of Councilmember Ken Gillanders a relationship was established with Hawkesburyshire, Australia. The students stay with host families whether they are here or we are over there. This important program has three main benefits: 1) cultural 2) educational 3) economic partnership. The Hawksbury is about the size of Los Angeles County.
