The house and furnishings were designed by Charles and Henry Greene in 1908 for David and Mary Gamble of the Procter and Gamble Company. The house, a National Historic Landmark, is owned by the City of Pasadena and operated by the University of Southern California and is open for public tours. Mike Miller wanted to be sure that USC was mentioned twice. Only in Southern California can you spend 3 million dollars refurbishing a \$50,000 house!
