LAST TUESDAY

Gary Kinsley talk to our club was entitled "The Atomic Biology Bomb". We quickly learned that it was the Genetically Engineered Bomb was food.

Gary graduated from UCLA in 1965 with a BA in Psychology, Peace Corps from 1966-1968, returned to college in 1970, 7 years at UCLA Hospital Clinical laboratory in Chemistry. He completed 30 years at the City of Hope Medical Center in Chemistry and Microbiology. He retired in March of this year.

The Monsanto Company is a multinational agricultural biotechnology corporation. It is the world's leading producer of the herbicide glyphosate, marketed in the Roundup brand, and in other brands. Monsanto is also the second largest producer of genetically engineered (GE) seed; it provides the technology in 49% of the genetically engineered seeds used in the US market.

Agracetus, owned by Monsanto, exclusively produces Roundup Ready soybean seed for the commercial market. In 2005, it finalized the purchase of Seminis Inc, making it the world's largest conventional seed company at the time.

Monsanto's development and marketing of genetically engineered seed and bovine growth hormone, as well as its aggressive litigation, political lobbying practices, seed commercialization practices and "strong-arming" of the seed industry have made the company controversial around the world and a primary target of the alter-globalization movement and environmental activists. In 2009 Monsanto came under scrutiny from the U.S. Justice Department, which began investigating whether the company's activities in the soybean markets were breaking anti-trust rules.

Dr. David Suzuki says, "Because we aren't certain about the effects of GMOs, we must consider one of the guiding principles in science, the precautionary principle. Under this principle, if a policy or action could harm human health or the environment, we must not proceed until we know for sure what the impact will be. And it is up to those proposing the action or policy to prove that it is not harmful."

This raises the question, at our Barbecue in July will we be serving genetically engineered corn or Kiwanis engineered corn?

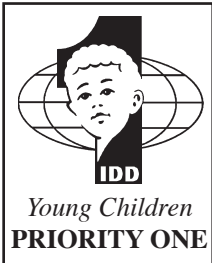
