Oak Avenue Intermediate School is taking a proactive approach to bullying through the Museum of Tolerance.

Oak Avenue Counselor Lori Johnson has put together this marvelous interactive program that shows the negative influence of bullying. I have had the privilege of attending this important events and found it to be very moving, especially when the students sign the No Bullying Pledge.

For the past 3 years, the Counseling and Guidance Department at Oak Avenue Intermediate School, with the support of school administration and staff, has facilitated a unique event designed to educate students regarding the destructive influence of bullying. For two days in March, the school library is turned into a museum which highlights the negative impacts of bullying on young people. Titled the Oak Avenue Museum of Tolerance, the project represents a collaborative effort of staff members who saw the value in delivering the message to students that all humans deserve respect.

The exhibits are comprised of student written work along with multimedia presentations. The objectives of this project are to promote acts of kindness on the campus, to give young people the tools and strategies to deal with conflict/harassment issues in a healthy way, and to make Oak a bully free school.

The 2008-2009 California Healthy Kids Survey gave the following results: 25% of 7th graders were harassed. 19% have been in a fight. 21% are afraid of being beat up.

91% of the Oak Avenue students had a positive impact after visiting the Museum of Tolerance on bullying.
