Carole Rodenbucher is a lady who is involved in many organization, least of which is Friends of Foster Children.

The mission of FOFC is to enhance the quality of life for abused, abandoned, and neglected children in the San Gabriel Valley. Founded in 1976, FOFC provides goods, volunteer services, and financial support to children living in residential treatment centers and to newly emancipated teens.

FOFC is an all-volunteer organization with no paid staff...so less than 6% of their annual budget is spent on operating costs.

Each month thousands of cases of suspected child abuse are reported to the Los Angeles County Department of Children & Family Services. Minors at serious risk of harm are placed in protective foster care. Those who suffer severe emotional problems are referred to residential treatment facilities.

I wonder about such a department that would allow a 8-year old boy from Palmdale to be murdered by his mother and boyfriend last week. Abuse was discovered long ago and nothing was done about it. I guess their case load is so big that occasionally a life falls through the cracks. Sad!!
