## LAST WEEK

Bob Sparnicht, PhD really does have a green thumb. The "Soil Man" gave us the history of the Gypsy Moth and Medfly. We live in a semi-arid desert which makes it a little difficult to grow anything without adding some amendments to the soil. Growers are now breeding vegetables for shipping and endurance rather than taste.

Jim Robuck, who does not have any problem growing hair on his face is plagued by nematodes which seem to be infesting his 33,000 square feet. A nematode is a large phylum of worms with slender, unsegmented, cylindrical bodies, including the roundworms, threadworms, and eelworms. They are found abundantly in soil and water, and many are parasites.

Dr. Bob says to be on the lookout for RIFA, Red Imported Fire Ants. RIFA's are between 1/16 to 1/4 inch in length, reddish-brown in color and extremely aggressive in behavior. They usually produce mounds of soft, crumbly soil that contain their colonies. When these colonies are disturbed by ground vibrations from footsteps, flooding from watering, or being uncovered and exposed to sunlight, the worker ants characteristically "boil out" of the mound and aggressively swarm over a victim and sting repeatedly.

Dr. Bob lives in Temple City and comes to us with a long list of titles. Associate Degree in Ornamental Horticulture, BA in Agriculture, Masters and Doctorate in Plant Pathology, Nobel Prize for being Pres. Jim's next door neighbor.

Among his places of employment were Assistant Dir. of Field Research, Thompson-Hayward Chemical Co; Agricultural Chemical Field Scientist, Velsicol Chemical Corp; Park Superintendent, City of Rosemead, Superintendent of Grounds, Hollywood Park.
