Phil Downs is a 30 year veteran of the California Highway Patrol. He spent most of his time in the desert pulling up along side of people doing 105 MPH. Phil has a lot of energy and he had way to much fun at his job.

Phil is not a big fan of AARP but he likes a program they have called Smart Driver. He teaches a eight-hour class over 2 days designed for seniors that help them be a safer driver.

Some things I learned from Phil were the leading cause of death is heart disease, second is cancer, and third is auto accidents. How many times have you thought the young drivers are the problem. The fact is that per mile driven seniors are the worst drivers.

Other misconceptions about driving are you can drive barefoot. You can pass a car in a intersection. You can make a u-turn over a double white line. You don't have to signal a lane change, only when other cars are around. Two big things I came away with are to avoid driving after dark and avoid making left turns. That is when the most accidents happen.

Phil does not get paid to teach this class. AARP charges \$15 for class materials. The course offers an important opportunity to learn how to drive more efficiently and safely. The content of the course can help you boost safety awareness, refresh and improve driving skills, minimize crash risk, increase confidence, prolong mobility, and maintain independence. Ninety-Three year old Dan has taken this class and can tell you how it has helped him. If we get 20 people together he will teach the class.
