Many thanks to Steve Tyre and his friendship with District Attorney Steve Cooley that brought us David Demerjian, Head Deputy with the Public Integrity Division.

David has been a prosecutor with the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office since 1983. Prior to his current assignment he served as the head deputy of the Major Narcotics Division. In 2001, newly elected District Attorney Steve Cooley created the Public Integrity Division and appointed David as the unit's first head deputy. The Public Integrity Division is responsible for the investigation and prosecution of public officials and public employees who commit crimes committed during the course of their official duties.

The Public Integrity Division has successfully prosecuted several high-profile cases against local public officials, and is currently prosecuting eight former city officials from the City of Bell for misappropriation of public funds and conflicts of interest.

David gave a fast-paced slide presentation with recent newspaper clippings of the cases they have successfully prosecuted. Of course we all sighed when clippings of Cathé Wilson and Judy Wong appeared on the screen. In these type of offenses there has to be a briber and a bribee. On more than one occasion have you heard people say "why is the briber not prosecuted and able to go free". David explained that you can not prosecute both. The briber often goes free if he/she can offer evidence (in this case phone conversations) to catch the bigger fish, elected officials. In all the cases that were portrayed on screen Temple City was a minor player in my estimation compared with the City of Bell and Cudahy who extracted millions from the citizens of their cities.

Our elected officials whether they be in city government, school governance, and employees of both are held to a very high standard. David and his team have successfully prosecuted over 200 cases of public distrust. Keep in mind that the PID will only investigate if a complaint is brought to them.

With the new leadership and city staff we are now able to go forward and actually be a model for other cities with integrity and transparency.

Guests in attendance were Lt. Silver Rivas, Ben and Becky Torres, and Linda Agajanian. We also had an Interclub from Monterey Park of Timothy Tin, Marie Peng, Steve Hayashi, and Margot Eiser. Others in attendance were Judy Lepore, Councilmember Carl Blum and his wife Jeanette Councilmember Tom Chavez and his wife Jane, Councilmember Fernando Vizcarra, and Mayor Pro Tem Cynthia Sternquist.

On a personal note, in my 42 years in Kiwanis this program ranked in the top three of all time. And remember integrity is doing the right thing when no one is looking.

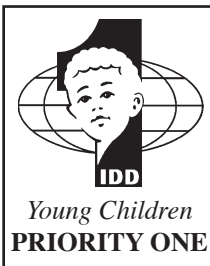
