Charles had many memorabilia items including pieces of the airplane that he was in when it was shot down.

According to my facts and figures: 16.1 million U.S. armed forces personnel served in between Dec. 1, 1941 and Dec 31, 1946. 33 months was the average length of active-duty. 73% were serving abroad. 292,000 made the supreme sacrifice of dying for our freedom. 671,000 were wounded. In the 2000 census there were 5.7 million veterans of World War II with 475,000 living in California. 210,000 is the estimated number of women who are WWII veterans. 76.7 is the median age of WWII veterans. 62 billion is the projected national expenditure for veteran's benefits.
