LAST TUESDAY

Jerry Selmer retired from a 31 year career with the City of Los Angeles in 1989. He was appointed Exec. Director of the Southwest Museum of the American Indian.

The Autry National Center, formed in 2003 by the merger of the Autry Museum of Western Heritage with the Southwest Museum of the American Indian and the Women of the West Museum, is an intercultural history center dedicated to exploring and sharing the stories, experiences, and perceptions of the diverse peoples of the American West.

Located in Griffith Park, the Autry's collection of over 500,000 pieces of art and artifacts, which includes the collection of the Southwest Museum of the American Indian, is one of the largest and most significant in the United States. The Autry Institute includes two research libraries: the Braun Research Library and the Autry Library. Exhibitions, public programs, K-12 educational services, and publications are designed to examine critical issues of society, offering insights into solutions and the contemporary human condition through the Western historical experience.

The Autry inhabits a unique niche of Western history and culture. Although there are exemplary art museums and many historic sites in our region, there is only one museum devoted to Western history and culture. The Autry is the only museum of its kind located in a major metropolitan center and the only museum that combines multiple Native American perspectives with Western histories and cultures in such a profoundly interconnected and multifaceted way.

No place welcomes so many traditions, ideas, cultures, and people as the Autry. As a museum-plus-education-plus-research institution, the Autry brings together the diverse experiences, collections, and creativity that symbolize the West.

Most of the artifacts were removed from the decaying building prior to 1990 by his unscrupulous predecessor. Jerry Selmer said "A museum is not a building, it is a collection". There are some in our club that might disagree.

Sue Chandler was in attendance to see the program. Elmer Black celebrates his birthday on July 10th. Dan Snell will jump from a plane this Saturday to help celebrate his 90th birthday. Mike Miller offered to drive Dan to the airport but Dan declined thinking it was safer jumping from a moving plane.
