Dawn Tarin was our speaker for the day giving us a glimpse of what will happen for 24 hours at Temple City High School football field. Temple City Relay for Life will conduct its 4th Annual Relay with 26 teams and over 300 participants.

Some important facts for you to consider as you contemplate participating in this worthwhile event. 1.5 million people have averted cancer during the past two decades, a 22% drop. 1,658,370 the number of new cancer cases expected to be diagnosed in 2015. 171,000 the estimated number of cancer deaths due to smoking. 231,840 the number of women expected to be diagnosed with invasive breast cancer. 220,800 the number of men expected to be diagnosed with prostate cancer in 2015, it is the most frequently diagnosed cancer in men, aside from skin cancer.

The Luminaria is one of the most inspirational and touching moments at Relay For Life. A Luminaria is simply a bag filled with a glowing light bearing the name of someone who has battled cancer. The candles will be around the track and will light a path in honor of someone who survived cancer or in memory of someone who did not survive.

We had an unofficial interclub with the San Gabriel club and all their members. Bob Bodkin, Larry Taylor, and coming in for the last 2 minutes was Dr. Royce Foster. Lauren Worsley from the American Cancer Society along with Marie Leonard paid a visit. Rich Wenzel was busy giving a wedding shower for their daughter and former Miss Temple City Kim Wenzel. Grampa Ron Dorazio was happy Tuesday at lunch after his 17-year-old grandson Max who had gone out for a hike on Devil's Canyon Trail the day before was rescued. "The searchers included the Montrose Search and Rescue Team and the father of one of the boys. The teens set out on Devil's Canyon Trail on Monday, but when they didn't return around 9:50 p.m., one of their mothers reported them missing to authorities. One of the boys' fathers (Ron's son-in-law) started searching on his own and met up with the search-and-rescue team. The boys were found just after 5:30 a.m. Tuesday, and both were flown out of the area. Devil's Canyon Trail is in the San Gabriel Mountains National Monument.

Relay for Life will happen this weekend for 24 hours beginning at 9 a.m. Saturday. Our club will be providing lunch for the 300 participants. Ed Chen from Athens will have his famous barbecue there along with grillers Rich Wenzel, Matt Smith, and Jim Robuck. Please arrive by 10:45 at the East end of the football field.
