Popularity of cremation is on the rise in the U.S.. More than a third of the 2.5 million Americans who die this year likely will be cremated rather than buried in caskets. Cremations are expected to reach 60% by the year 2025.

Forest Lawn is 107 years old with 9 properties with varying prices depending on location. If your family member does no mind the heat Forest Lawn in Indio and the Coachella Valley would be a little cheaper. Mausoleums are more expensive because they are air conditioned!!

With our changing demographics Forest Lawn does not have an Asian section as found at Rose Hills. They don't want any segregation.

This is a sad fact. With burial property becoming more scarce our Veteran Cemeteries are burying our heros standing up. How do you feel about that?

Burials at Forest Lawn range in price from \$2,700 single to \$240,000 for the family plan. I have heard it said that the size of your funeral depends on the weather.

The Federal Trade Commission, established in 1914 under president Woodrow Wilson as a government agency to investigate and eliminate unfair and deceptive practices in business, enacted the Funeral Rule on April 30, 1984, and amended it effective 1994.

The Funeral Rule was designed to protect consumers by requiring that they receive adequate information concerning the goods and services they may purchase from a funeral provider.

All funeral providers must comply with The Funeral Rule. The Funeral Rule defines such terms as, among others, funeral provider, funeral goods and funeral services and specifies various consumer rights, as well as specific parameters in which funeral industry goods and service providers must respect consumer rights and conduct their business.

Next time you go to Costco check out the coffins on the right as you exit.
