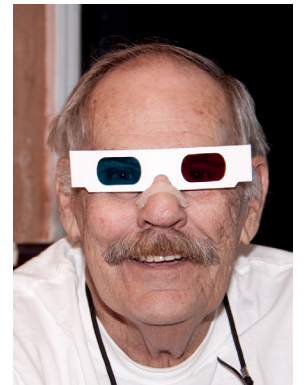
Deputy Rich Soto from Temple Station will give us an update on crime in our fair city. Rich is truly one of the good guys who genuinely cares about Temple City.

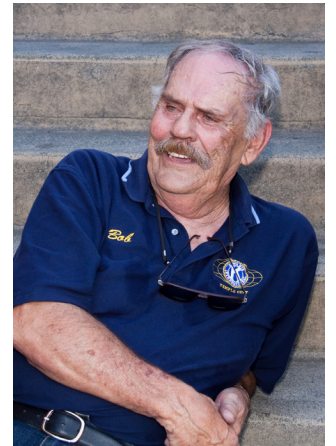
