We had a good time critiquing the Barbecue last weekend. Treasurer Matt Smith gave some preliminary numbers that were somewhat discouraging. He reported we had 127 paid adults and 26 children. Last year we had 182 adults and that was also a decline. I know the numbers but as I looked around it seemed to me that there were more people than 153.

A theory was possibly discovered that the decline was in direct correlation to us not putting up the big banner on Las Tunas. The installation of the banner is about \$500 which has to be weighed against lost revenue.

Treasurer Matt stated our net revenue would be about \$3,500 which is about \$2,500 less than usual. Concern was expressed about the cost of the eclairs being more than the meat. \$2.00 a piece which is 10% of the adult ticket price and 27% of the kids meal.

I must admit that this was probably one of our better barbeques including the quality of the beef and chicken. Many thanks to Dave Seltman and Steve Montesanti who were tireless in cooking and slicing. Also, Steve's son-in-law Anthony was a big help. New member Walter Chu displayed his BBQ talents.

Sue Matchett with a lot of help from Carole Rodenbucher did an outstanding job with the opportunity drawing. Many thanks to Tom McIntee with his sound system.
