THIS TUESDAY

Ellen Velasquez from the Red Cross will teach us how to be "Red Cross Ready"

Each year, thanks to your time and financial support, the Red Cross responds to about 70,000 disasters across the nation. Most of these events impact one family at a time, whether it's a flood, fire, medical emergency or hurricane. We all need to be ready to respond to an event when help may be delayed.

LAST TUESDAY

Dr. Hanson Lee, a gastroenterologist from Arcadia Methodist Hospital spoke to us about prevention and **early detection of colorectal cancer.**

Dr. Lee received his Fellowship in Gastroenterology from UCLA/Harbor. He received his B.A. from Berkeley and medical degree from Ohio State University. He completed his residency at UCLA/Harbor Medical Center.

Dr. Lee gave an excellent powerpoint presentation with much of the information from the American Cancer Society. Colorectal cancer is the #3 most common cancer and the #2 cancer killer. Only 40% of colorectal cancer is detected in the early stages. Dr. Lee touted taking calcium and aspirin to help stave off those ugly polyps.

Colorectal cancer, also called colon cancer or bowel cancer, includes cancerous growths in the colon, rectum and appendix. It is the third most common form of cancer and the second leading cause of death among cancers in the Western world. Colorectal cancer causes 655,000 deaths worldwide per year. Many colorectal cancers are thought to arise from adenomatous polyps in the colon. These mushroom-like growths are usually benign, but some may develop into cancer over time. The majority of the time, the diagnosis of localized colon cancer is through colonoscopy. Therapy is usually through surgery, which in many cases is followed by chemotherapy.

Guests also attending our meeting were Al and Theda Topalian from the La Crescenta/Flintridge Kiwanis Club. Our Assemblyman Anthony Portantino is also a member of that club. Al and Theda's son Darrell is Vice-Principal at Oak Avenue Intermediate School.
