Superintendent of Temple City Schools Dr. Joan Hillard will give us an update for the new school year.

LAST TUESDAY

Our own Mike Miller proved to use that his attending the International Convention in San Antonio was not a vacation.

Mike returned with all kinds of printed material from the convention including his certificate for completion from Kiwanis University.

Mike attended his first Int'l Convention as President-Elect in 1985 at Toronto, Canada. Since then he has attended 5 other Conventions with various District Conventions.

Kiwanis is now at 260,000 strong with a goal of 1 million by the year 2015. The average age of a Kiwanian is 57. The average size of club is 34 members. Average age of a new member is 47. The average time spent as a member of Kiwanis is 5 years.

Mike said that Kiwanis is trying to take on a corporate image by hiring paid professionals, including our International President. Mike made an impassioned plea to carry on the work of our club, not for ourselves, but for the next generation of Kiwanis members. "If we fail, we fail the Key Club", Mike said. Mike has been in Kiwanis for 26, and 37 years for me. Mike and I both have a passion for Kiwanis, but Mike went the extra mile: Distinguished President twice, Distinguished Lt. Governor, Secretary, Treasurer, Division 10 Secretary and Treasurer, Hixon Fellow, and Life Member.

President Elmer passed out copies of a Kiwanis bulletin from December 1978 which showed 5 Honorary Members, 14 Senior Members, and 54 Active Members. How things have changed! Interesting to see that 10 of those 73 members are still in our club after 29 years.

The recent BBQ was reported to be the best ever financially. The Board voted to give the Blue Star Banner Program \$1,000 to help replace worn banners. Thanks to those who donated time, talent, and \$\$\$, especially Kiwanis supporter Helen Hoffmann.

Guests also attending our meeting were Sam Tyre and John Tyre, also Philip.
