Here's John again:

"During our meeting of August 9, a lively discussion was held as a debriefing of the 2005 BBQ. As reminders to next year's BBQ leadership, the pros and cons of many aspects of the event were dissected.

"Of particular note was the topic of estimation of the number of dinners to prepare. The idea that no procedure will be 100% accurate was accepted. Better communication between the ticket sellers and leadership somehow must be emphasized.

"We are getting better (but still not perfect) at the serving line. Or lines (2) were good. Problems with speed were analyzed, suggestions for meat and salad preparation were presented, even the watermelon idea drew comments.

"How do we keep from being 20 to 25 minutes late -- start preparation 20 to 25 minutes earlier - DUH! Karaoke will probably continue. Speed of prize distribution will be addressed.

"An excellent idea of having a mock BBQ at a member's home to sample meats, cooking methods, etc. was presented.

"Overall we did a pretty good job this year. Preliminary indications are that this will be one of our very best financially. If we can clear 2 or 3 problems each year, discussions such as this are well worth it."
