Rhonda Beltran from the McKinley Children's Center has been a professional fundraiser for 28 years and has held the position of Chief Development Officer for the organization since 1997.

McKinley Children's Center is located in San Dimas between the 10 and 210 freeway, near Raging Waters. McKinley has a reputable history dedicated to providing a safe and secure environment for children to heal and develop hopeful futures. Since 1900, McKinley has served thousands of children whose lives were touched by loss, trauma, neglect, and/or abuse. For over 115 years McKinley offers a variety of programs that not only help children, but also their families, and communities.

The program assists boys that range in age from six to seventeen by providing for their physical, emotional, educational, and social needs. Professional staff, skilled in a variety of methods, provide individual, group, family treatment, and recreational activities.

The Foster Family and Adoption Agency of McKinley specializes in providing infants, children and adolescents with the comfort; privacy and nurturing of a family home in which to heal their wounds of abuse and neglect. At present there are 25 boys in residence with the youngest at 1 day and the oldest at 22 years. They are licensed by the County for 28 and provide service to over 5,000 children a year. The average stay is 6 to 18 months.
