## THIS TUESDAY

The following is a news headline from Wednesday, August 16th. Just in time, the program will be on West Nile Virus.

"A 65-year-old Saratoga man is the first person in Santa Clara County this year to contract West Nile virus, local health officials said Tuesday.

A mild case of the mosquito-borne illness was confirmed Monday, said Santa Clara County Public Health Department spokeswoman Joy Alexiou. The man suffered from fatigue and a body rash, but did not have to be hospitalized and "is pretty much back to his normal activities," Alexiou said.

Last year, five human cases of the virus were reported in the county, she said. The first of 2005 was reported on Aug. 16.

There have been 39 human cases reported in California so far this year, according to the state health officials, and none has been fatal. Santa Clara County is the only Bay Area county that has reported a case in humans this year, but the virus has been found in birds or mosquitoes in Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Mateo and Sonoma counties.

Last year, 935 Californians were stricken by the West Nile virus, and 19 died from it. Alexiou suggested residents get rid of standing water, repair broken screens and use a mosquito repellent with DEET. If a person is bit and feels fever, fatigue, body aches, headaches or other flulike symptoms, he or she should see a doctor, she said."

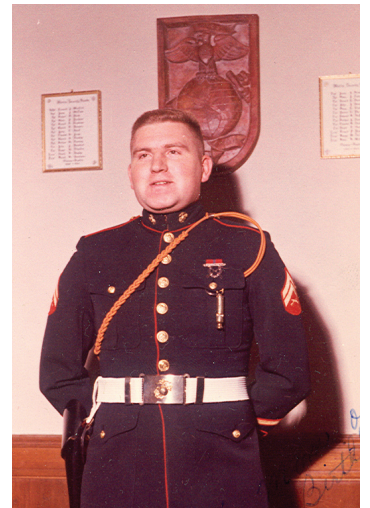
