I can remember he was always the first person to pay for Barbecue tickets before anyone else. He contributed financially to many worthwhile projects over the years.

In speaking to his granddaughter Sandra it has not been determined cause of death because Tony had not seen a doctor since 1942. The assumption is complications from COPD.

A Memorial Service is planned for 11 a.m. Friday, August 30 at Rose Hills, Gate 1 (main gate). The location is the Garden of Remembrance.
