Our new City Manager Jose Pulido was our guest speaker for the day. Jose is married to Laura and they have 4 children. Jose has a strong background in redevelopment having graduated from Cal Berkeley and spending 9 years at San Fernando and 9 years in Montebello. His philosophy is not to just keep 3/5ths of the Council happy but to do the best for its citizens.

Jose has established a goal of turning Temple City government from a status quo organization to a High Performance City. Jose has been given 2 goals: 1) to produce a balanced city budget with 2 million less and keep the same level of services, 2) to become a high performance city with outstanding customer service. In an effort to increase the City's transparency and to create consistency both at the City Council level as well as at the City Commission level a City Council Protocols has been written.

Jose also gave updates on the Alpha Beta property and the Rosemead-Las Tunas property. I think we would all agree that Temple City is under served in the area of parks. To that end the City will attempt to collaborate with the School District, City of Arcadia and Rosemead to share resources.

Job opportunities for Temple City include a Community Development Director, Economic Development person, and a Code Enforcement Manager.
