Her recovery began there and Lynne witnessed the transformation and made the decision at that time she would like to be a part of the Pet Therapy program.

Huntington Hospital was the second hospital in the nation to offer Pet Therapy. The program offers two important benefits including Socialization and Physiological benefits. Test have shown that the decrease in heart rate and blood pressure during a pet visitation can be dramatic.

THE END OF AN ERA

It is with sadness I report the passing of Margot Youmans. Margot was the wife of former member Ray Youmans. Margot, age 84 passed away peacefully on Sunday August 25, 2013 at her home in Sierra Vista, AZ after a long battle with cancer. Ray was a proud Kiwanis member, I remember the great times we had including a weight loss contest.

Margot was born in Fuerth, Germany on January 7, 1929. She met her husband, Robert Arthur Youmans (Ray) who was in the army and stationed in Germany, while Margot was working as a secretary for the 3rd Army Division in Fuerth. They were married at the Post Chapel. They made their home in the early years in Fond du Lac, WI where two of their four children were born. They moved to Temple City, CA where Robert started his own business with Standard Oil. They had two more children. The Chevron station on the corner of Oak Avenue and Las Tunas was a fixture from 1952 to 1998.

Margot was very active in various Masonic and civic organizations including Eastern Star where she was a 30-year member and Soroptomist. She was a big supporter of the Shrine, Jobs Daughters, Demolay and high school band. In 1992 after Ray retired they moved to Sierra Vista, AZ where they continued to be active with the Sierra Vista Methodist Church and other organizations.

Funeral Services will be held at the Church of the Good Sheppard in Arcadia, CA on Wednesday September 4th at 10:00 am followed by interment at Live Oak Memorial Park in Monrovia, CA. Margot was a beautiful person inside and out.

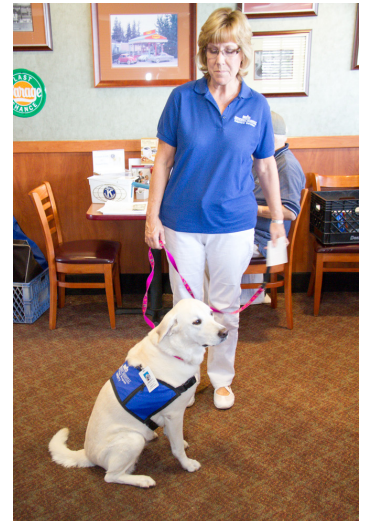
