Joseph Smith, Educational Consultant with Tudor Doctor, will present, "In Home Tutoring with Tudor Doctor." They are the leader in providing affordable education in North America. We will also be voting for the revised bylaw changes and dues structure.

Roger Ruiz was our speaker for the day. He is from Nu Quest Industries in Monrovia. Nu Quest is a residential management company with over 15 years experience. They are dedicated to help homeowner receive education on the inefficiencies of older homes. They are currently working on Steve Montesanti's home and his home will be 100 years old in January.

Nu Quest is certified by Southern California Gas Company and Southern California Edison. 115 million dollars are available for California through a state approved program called Energy Upgrade California. The state has set an ambitious goal to reduce home energy use by 40 percent by the year 2020.

The utilities are offering \$300 to \$4,500 to help offset the cost of energy upgrades. You are free to choose a Participating Contractor for a home energy assessment to help you identify energy efficiency improvements customized for your home. Of course they would want you to choose them to do the work.

The typical homeowner achieves about 30% in energy savings after completing upgrades. The size of the rebate depends on the percentage of the increase in your home's efficiency, not the cost of what you do.
