Our own Dr. Chelsea Kang-Smith was our program for the day. All the bases were covered as John was wearing Bruin Blue and Chelsea was wearing USC Crimson Red.

On July 18 the Governing Board of Temple City Unified School District voted to adopt a resolution ordering an election for a bond measure to raise \$128.8 million. The bond measure is now known as Measure S on the November 6 general ballot.

Chelsea gave the report that all the elementary schools have a score of 900 and above. Temple City High School is at 880. In the No Child Left Behind Act schools are doing great if they have a score of 800. Temple City is a district of 7 schools, of which all are California Distinguished Schools.

Temple City's property values are among the highest in Los Angeles County due largely to the excellence of our outstanding, high-achieving schools.

Yes on S protects high quality instruction in core subjects, math, science, reading and writing by making necessary repairs to our local schools. Every Temple City neighborhood will receive funding with the largest portion allocated to TCHS. There will be an oversight committee committed to make sure that all the bond proceeds are used for repairs, upgrades, health and safety. None of the funds can be used for administration, pensions, or teacher salaries.

The last bond issue was 14 years ago and since that time our wonderful California politicians have cut the budgets of school district by 1/5th. Measure S payments are based on assessed value, not market valuation. Long time property owners (pre Prop 13) will pay less. The bond is for 25 years and the amount is set at \$58.80 per \$100,000 of assessed value per year. The average assessed value in Temple City is about \$300,000. Typically, the assessed value has been about 25% of the actual home value.

If the Governors Tax Measure 30 on the ballot in November does not pass the district will have to make cuts of \$2.6 million starting with the 2013-2014 budget.
