## THIS TUESDAY

## LAST TUESDAY

Cynthia Sternquist holds a Masters in Educational Administration and has taught in both the private and public schools for a total of 30 years. Her recent years in education were spent teaching in a model alternative school for junior high students who were pregnant, recently incarcerated, or unable to be successful in a regular educational environment. Before her recent retirement from education, Cynthia served as Literacy Coach and mentor teacher for the First Five Program in the Mountain View school district in El Monte.

She has received numerous educational awards, was selected as one of two teachers to represent the US at International Space Camp in Huntsville Alabama, awarded two teaching American History grants in which she attended a two week academy in Colonial Williamsburg, and another on Civil War History held across the Civil war battlefields and ending in Washington DC.

Cynthia served as a parks and recreation commissioner for 19 years before moving to the planning commission for 3 months and then appointed to City Council to fill Dave Capra's term when he left office. She was then elected to City Council in 2011 and is six months into her term as Mayor.

In my 44 years in Kiwanis this is the first time a speaker has gone to the Kiwanis website to find our vision statement. "Kiwanis International is a global organization of volunteers dedicated to changing the world one child and one community at a time."

Mayor Sternquist spoke passionately about some of her favorite subjects...Brush With Kindness, Citizen's Academy, Home Beautiful Awards, Foothill Fitness Challenge at City Of Hope, and the Town Hall Meeting that will take place on Thursday, September 26 at First Baptist Church. Topics include City Budgeting and Finance, Community Preservation, and Economic Development.

After a two year hiatus Habitat For Humanity Brush With Kindness is starting up again with 6 houses scheduled for rehab. If you can help with some of these projects please contact City Hall.
