I asked Sean what it would take to have Trader Joe's relocate to Temple City considering it is so difficult to get in and out of their location in San Gabriel. He said they lease almost all their 345 locations. They look for sites that are a few blocks away from the major shopping because the lease rates are lower. I perceive that their locations are just the opposite, they are very visible in high traffic areas. We suggested the former Young's Market at the corner of Lower Azusa and Temple City Blvd.

The Mission of Trader Joe's is to give their customers the best food and beverage values that they can find anywhere and to provide them with the information required for informed buying decisions. They provide these with a dedication to the highest quality of customer satisfaction delivered with a sense of warmth, friendliness, fun, individual pride and company spirit.

My two favorite places to spend my money are In-n-Out and Trader Joe's. I have never been met with a grumpy employee at either these establishments. They are happy to serve your needs with a smile, something some Temple City merchants need to emulate.
