**"California At War" Part 2**

In the weeks after Pearl Harbor submarines of the Japanese Imperial Navy torpedoed ships and refineries off the California coast. Crewmen were killed, ships sank, and panic took over. This panic led to what is now known as the "Battle of Los Angeles." Only one man died in this imagined invasion but thirty people were arrested the next day, twenty of them Japanese Americans.

Prejudice wasn't new in California, but in the name of "patriotism" it reached new heights. Best known is the internment of more than 100,000 Japanese, but even the state's oldest population, the Latinos of Mexican and Spanish decent, became targets.

Carpal tunnel syndrome occurs when the median nerve, which runs from the forearm into the hand, becomes pressed or squeezed at the wrist. The median nerve controls sensations to the palm side of the thumb and fingers (although not the little finger), as well as impulses to some small muscles in the hand that allow the fingers and thumb to move. The carpal tunnel - a narrow, rigid passageway of ligament and bones at the base of the hand that houses the median nerve and tendons.

Sometimes, thickening from irritated tendons or other swelling narrows the tunnel and causes the median nerve to be compressed. The result may be pain, weakness, or numbness in the hand and wrist, radiating up the arm. Although painful sensations may indicate other conditions, carpal tunnel syndrome is the most common and widely known of the entrapment neuropathies in which the body's peripheral nerves are compressed or traumatized.
