ART'S HOUSEHOLD TIPS

Soon winter will be upon us so here is a tip on Re-lighting your Pilot Lights. Turn the control valve OFF, then turn to the PILOT position. Push the RED button, or (in newer models, the valve itself) to release gas to the pilot light. Light with a match; don't let up on the valve for 60 seconds until the thermocouple warms up. Release the button and set the control to ON. If your heater doesn't light or the pilot light won't stay lit, call the Gas Company for assistance. IT'S FREE. Of course you don't have a home to do all these things...go see Art Luna, Elmer Black, or Dan Snell.
