Ten members and one guest took a tour of our Temple 5 Sheriff's Station. The personalized tour was conducted by Captain Chris Nee. Our Station serves the communities of Temple City, Duarte, Bradbury, So. El Monte, So. San Gabriel, and surrounding unincorporated areas.

LASD Temple Station's Police Station Visitors Week (PSVW) event, which was held globally from November 3 - 9. PSVW is a unique global event that invites groups of community members to assess the quality of service delivered by local police departments, to identify best practices and to strengthen ties between police and the communities they serve. This event has occurred in more than 40 countries around the world, and has attracted more than 15,000 visitors to more than 5,000 local police stations

Members taking the tour were Elmer Black, Rich Wenzel, Jerry Jambazian, Jim Robuck, Mike Lepore, Henry Walpus, Steve Tyre, and Bob Rodenbucher. Also attending were wives Cheryl Robuck and Carole Rodenbucher. Also, Sam Hodson, a Pastor at First Baptist Church attended.

After the tour we completed a questionnaire with twenty questions that ranged on Community Orientation, Physical Conditions, Equal Treatment of the Public, Transparency and Accountability, and Detention Conditions. All in all it was very informative and we were treated very well.

I am personally pleased that Temple City is a contract city. Instead of having our own police department at \$9 million per year, we contract with LASD to provide service for \$3 million per year. We pay for 3 police cars and a motor officer. If there is a major emergency the full resources of the County are available to the City. Plus we don't have to worry about pensions and all that other stuff.
