LAST TUESDAY

World War II Veteran Lyle Umenhoffer recalled his days serving on the USS Indianapolis. Lyle was born in Santa Ana in 1923 and moved to San Gabriel soon after.

Lyle told of actually wanting to join the Marines. He showed up at the recruiting office to be greeted by a staff more interested in going to lunch rather than sign him up. He said "forget you" and went across the hall and signed with the Navy.

Lyle served on the USS Indianapolis during his Navy career. He did not know it at the times but his ship transported the Atom Bomb that was detonated on August 9, 1945 in Japan. He witnessed many of his Navy buddies losing their life at sea. Many times they were hit by enemy gunfire and bombs. One 500 pound bomb went through each level of the ship and detonated at the bottom.

Lyle was an excellent speaker recalling very well his service to our country. His favorite quip was "Anything that stands still you paint it, anything that moves you salute". After his service he had a forty-year career with So. California Gas.
