Habitat For Humanity will be the program for today. After a two year hiatus Habitat has started again in Temple City. The City is funding "Brush With Kindness" for six homes at \$6,000 each. Two homes have already been completed.

Carole Rodenbucher is a Daughter of the American Revolution. Carole gave the history and genealogy of her grandfather Robert Tate Sedam, born in 1839 and passed away in 1929. On April 19, 1861 he enlisted for three years having been the 42nd man to enlist on the call for 300,000 men.

The Civil War was fought from 1861 to 1865 with Gettysburg suffering the most casualties with 51,000. Roughly 1,264,000 American soldiers have died in the nation's wars - 620,000 in the Civil War and 644,000 in all other conflicts including 405,000 from WWII, 116,000 from WWI, and 58,000 from Vietnam.
