Lou Merritt was recently honored with the distinguished 50 year Legion Of Honor award. Lou joined Temple City Kiwanis in 1955 and its President in 1985. Kiwanis meets weekly, for those of you who like math, that equates to 2,600 lunches.

Lou was born 1918 in Pueblo, Colorado and moved to Temple City from Los Angeles in 1947 and opened Lou's Key and Lock Shop on March 9, 1949. Lou served in the Navy in World War II and was honorably discharged in July, 1945. Lou is also a member of Temple City American Legion, Post 279.

After the successful incorporation of Temple City in 1960, Lou served on the first City Council, he served 4 times as Mayor and retired from the Council in 1982. Lou also served as the first President of the Temple City Historical Society. Lou was married to Ruth in 1940 and they were blessed with eight children, and many grandchildren. When a member had a happy event in their life they would pay a "happy dollar". Lou was graciously able to pay many happy dollars. Congratulations Lou!!
