The Old Mill, AKA El Molino Viejo creates a fascinating link with the past as they celebrate their 200 year anniversary next year. Completed about 1816 as a grist mill for Mission San Gabriel, the Old Mill today stands as a testament to the legacy of the California missions and Spanish presence in early California.

The building is a two-story adobe structure with walls built in layers as thick as five feet. It was designated as a California State Historic Landmark in 1939. The mill was bequeathed to the City of San Marino in 1962. In 1995 The Old Mill Foundation was established to maintain, preserve, and operate *El Molino Viejo*. The Old Mill is located at 1120 Old Mill Road. They are open one to four in the afternoon Tuesday through Sunday.

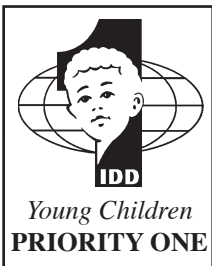
