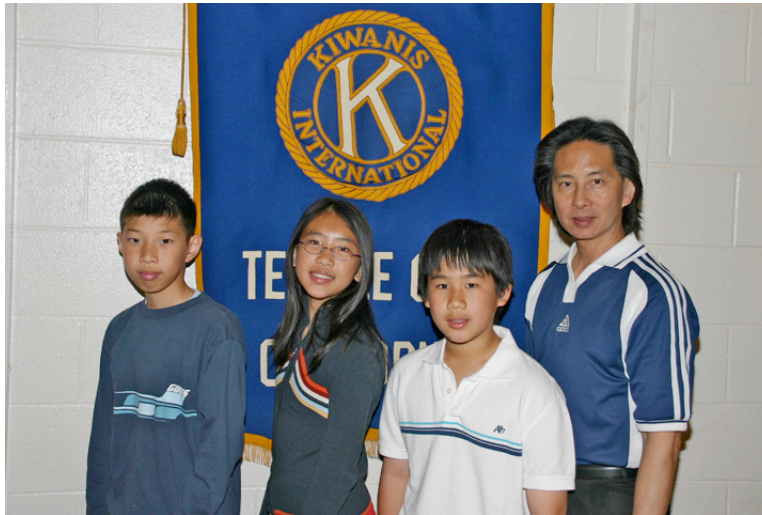


**Kiwanis Honors Cloverly Students
